- A skin allergy test must be done 48 hours before each use of this product to avoid reactions. Take no risk. (see the instruction leaflet).
- **DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT:**
 - if you have already had a reaction to a hair colourant.
 - if your scalp is sensitive, itchy or damaged, or if you have scalp abrasions.
- **BLACK/HENNA TATTOO:** if you have ever had a black henna tattoo, at any time in your life, you are at greater risk of an allergic reaction. **DO NOT USE** this product unless you've conducted a skin allergy test 48 hours before use.

Skin Allergy Test

Some people are allergic to colouring products. Allergies can develop suddenly, even after regular use of hair dyeing products. For this reason, the allergy test must be done 48 hours before each application.

1. Wash and dry a test area about the size of a coin in the bend of your elbow or behind your ear.

2. Prepare test mixture in a plastic or glass container by mixing a small amount of colouring shampoo with developer in the ratio of 1:1. Then apply to the test area with cotton ball.

3. Wait for 48 hours without disturbing the test area. If no reaction has occurred, you are ready to use the Lovers Hair Salon colouring shampoo on your hair.

Note: If any abnormal reactions - such as redness burning, itching swelling, skin abrasions, eruptions or irritations appear in or around the test area, they may indicate hypersensitivity and you should not use this product.

Colour Review Test

Hair colour results can be affected by permanent waving, straightening, overexposure to the sun, previous colouring, quantity of grey hair, hair condition and other stress factors. This test is the only reliable way to preview the colour.

1. Snip a small swatch of hair ¼ inch wide and tape on end.
2. Prepare test mixture using the same method as the allergy test, or you may use the remaining mixture from the allergy test.
3. Place the swatch in the mixture, making sure that each strand is completely covered.
4. Leave for about 7 - 8 minutes.
5. Rinse and dry well to preview your colour results. According to colour result, add or reduce waiting time when applying to your whole hair.

Note: Shampoo your hair 24 hours before colouring if your hair is soiled or has a heavy build up of styling products. Apply on wet hair that has been towelled dry.

- The developer contains hydrogen peroxide.
- The colouring shampoo contains resorcinol.
- Avoid contact of the product with skin and eyes. Do not use to colour eyelashes and eyebrows. To do so may cause serious eye injuries and/or blindness.
- Rinse eyes immediately with water if product comes into contact with eyes.
- Wear gloves supplied in the carton.
- Rinse hair thoroughly after application.
- Keep out of reach of children. Do not use on children.

Precautions

If after colouring or on the following days you experience problems such as skin or scalp itching, skin or scalp rash, swelling to eyes/face and blistering, seek medical advice.

This product contains ingredients which may cause severe eye irritation and possible permanent eye damage. If developer or colouring shampoo mixture gets into eyes, flush immediately with a large amount of water and seek medical advice.

If swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to stop by the Poisons Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with running water.

- Do not use this hair colour over metallic dyes, compound hennas, hair colour spray or colour restores.
- Do not use this hair colour after a permanent waving or straightening. Allow a week before or after a permanent wave or straightening before dyeing your hair.
- Do not use a metal comb or any metallic utensils.
- Do not prepare mixture until ready to use. Do not save any unused mixture; container

may burst. Empty the unused portion properly and discard the container.

- Do not shave before or during colouring
- Do not use on facial hair such as male beard and moustache.
- Use at room temperature for best colour results.
- Protect clothing and work area to avoid permanent staining.
- To prevent skin from staining, apply petroleum jelly or cold cream to your ears and all around the hairline. If staining occurs, dip a towel in normal shampoo and remove the stain immediately.
- In case of close cut hair, the hair can not be dyed; so apply the mixture in its fullness and place a tissue to help the penetration of the mixture into hair.

- **Hair colouring as you shampoo hair**
Since it can be applied with your hands as you shampoo your hair, the application is very easy and quick.
- **Quick grey hair coverage**
It takes only 7 - 8 minutes for grey hair coverage, so you can also finish the colouring process while taking a shower.
- **Henna Oriental Herbs**
The advanced formula enriched with high concentration of henna, squid ink, oriental herb extracts significantly reduces damage to hair, maintaining your hair's health and silkiness.
- **Hair protecting effect**
The soybean protein included in the formulation protects hair cuticle from damage leaving hair healthy and silky.
- **No ammonia**
It is a pleasant colouring experience with a fresh scent without the strong ammonia smell.

Helpful Hints

- Do not allow the product to come into contact with clothing or jewellery as stains may not be able to be removed.
- It is recommended repeating the application every 4 weeks to retouch the roots and regrowth.
- Lovers Hair Salon range of Colouring Shampoos are designed to work in 7 - 8 minutes on predominantly grey hair.
- Use at room temperature for best colour results.
- To prevent skin from staining, apply petroleum jelly or cold cream to your ears and all around the hairline. If staining occurs, dip a towel in normal shampoo and remove the stain immediately.
- In case of close cut hair, colour results may vary. Apply the mixture in its fullness and place a tissue to help the penetration of the mixture into hair.
- Do not use a metal comb or any metallic utensils.

1. Preparation

Before starting the application, protect your clothing and have a watch nearby so you can monitor processing time. The application is easier if you apply to wet hair.

- 1 x **No. 1** Colouring Shampoo (60ml tube)
- 1 x **No. 2** Developer (60ml tube)
- 1 x pair of gloves and cape
- 1 x instruction leaflet
- 1 x treatment conditioner
- 1 x comb-rush

Put on the gloves supplied and cover your clothing with the cape supplied. Make sure you also cover surfaces that may stain.



2. Mixing

Open Colouring Shampoo (No. 1) tube and Developer (No. 2) tube by piercing the tube seal with reverse side of cap. Squeeze equal amount of Colouring Shampoo (No. 1) and Developer (No. 2) onto your hands and mix well.



2. Application

Leaving your gloves on, apply the prepared Colouring Shampoo mixture. Apply the colour mixture to hair in the manner of shampooing. Using the supplied brush will help evenly apply mixture.

NOTE: The colouration mixture of some shades changes its colour during the mixing process. This is normal and doesn't influence the colour result.

ALL OVER COLOUR

This application is recommended if

- you are colouring your hair permanently for the first time.
- your previous hair colour has totally grown out or been washed out.

Apply the prepared colour mixture with your hands or a comb, strand by strand on all of your hair. Start the application where you have the most greys. Make sure the mixture is spread evenly and that your hair is fully covered. Massage the mixture thoroughly into the hair.



Leave the mixture on for 7-8 minutes.

Note: Shampoo your hair 24 hours before colouring if your hair is soiled or has a heavy build up of styling products. Apply on wet hair that has been towelled dry.

REGROWTH APPLICATION

Root regrowth treatment is necessary if

- your hair has been coloured and the regrowth is visible.
- the ends of your hair are darker or in poor condition.

Apply the prepared colour mixture with your hands or a comb. Apply two thirds of the prepared colour mixture to the regrowth area by first dividing the hair, section by section. Apply the mixture along the parting. Use the small comb and brush to get to roots near scalp.

When desired colour is reached, rinse thoroughly with warm water until water runs clear.



Condition your hair with supplied Conditioning Treatment to seal in the colour and shine.
